Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 26th ultimo enclosing one from Mr. Mares in further reference to the masts of the steamer "Camosun" built under special survey at Paisley last year, and with regard thereto I am directed to say that although the pillaring in way of the masts appears to be satisfactory it is considered that it would have been advantageous if the plating under the heels of the masts had been supported by a fore and aft carling between the beams, and it is suggested that provision should accordingly be made in any future similar case.

I enclose herewith a copy of a letter which has this day been addressed to the Owners on the subject.
