3. Were you present at any of the vessel's trials? If so at which?
4. Were the materials and workmanship used in the engine department in accordance with Lloyd's Rules in every respect?
5. Were the boiler mountings, valves for feed pump and Salinometer cocks fitted subject to your approval?
6. Were the joints properly tight between the H.P. and J.P. cylinders?
