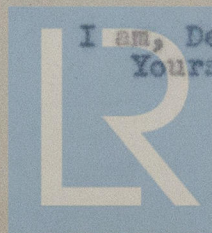
M. I beg to return herewith one copy of each of the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 6th instant, of midship section, profile and decks of the Single Screw Steamer No. 518 proposed to be built by your goodselfs, and with regard thereto I have pleasure in stating that provided the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended be adhered to, the Rules in all other respects be complied with, and the materials and workmanship be to the Society's satisfaction, the vessel will be eligible to be classed 100A1, with a freeboard corresponding to a draught not exceeding that contemplated by the Rules for a complete superstructure vessel having a tonnage opening.

In view of the concentration of loading represented by the bunker coal disposed as stated, together with the water ballast in the deep tank aft as per your letter of the 6th instant, additional stiffening has been indicated on the upper deck plan in the form of a girder and larger doublings.

The duplicate plans are being retained for record.
