I am in receipt of your letter of the 26th ultimo, with enclosures, respecting Messrs. John Readhead & Sons Ltd., Yard No. 515, and I have to inform you that the plan of main boilers will be approved for a working pressure of 220 lb. per sq. inch, provided the boilers be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile strength of the shell plates, but straps and girder plates, viz:- 29/33 tons per sq. inch.

Further, the plan of auxiliary boiler will be approved for a working pressure of 220 lb. per sq. inch, provided the boiler be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile of the shell plates, butt straps, girders and manhole compensating plate, viz:- 29/33 tons per sq. inch.

One set of the plans in question is returned herewith.
