

The Second Special Survey No.2 became due on this small tanker in November, 1935, and at the request of the late Owners, the Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co., Ltd., the Committee, in April last, agreed to its postponement until the end of the year of grace.

She was recently sold to Messrs. Hemsley, Bell, Ltd., who state that they do not propose continuing her class, as the machinery is being removed and structural alterations being effected to convert her into a Dumb Oil Barge for the purpose of oil lighterage in Southampton Water.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Thursday, 31st ultimo, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (. . .) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
