**FIRST ENTRY**

Nature of Survey .....

It is submitted that before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Amsterdam Surveyors should be informed that this vessel is proceeding to their port for the purpose of being fitted with her machinery.

To complete the survey for classification the following remains to be done:— Through beam in engine casing to be fitted to suit machinery, pillars in motor room to be fitted to suit arrangement of machinery; motor room skylight to be riveted, windlass to be fitted, bower anchors, stream and kedg anchors to be supplied.

The Surveyors should be requested to give the case the necessary attention, and on completion of the work to their satisfaction forward a report on form No.8 with a view to the classification of the vessel.
