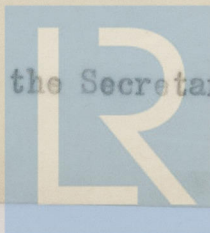
I have pleasure in certifying that the steel screw steamer "BOGSTAD", built by Messrs. Lithgows, Limited, Port Glasgow, is being constructed under the Special Survey of the Society's Surveyors at Greenock, who report that the vessel is expected to be completed about the end of July and will be recommended for the class+100A1. Upon the receipt of the reports from the Surveyors the case will be submitted to the Committee of the Society in the usual way, after which the certificates will be issued.

In the circumstances I shall be much obliged if you will be so good as to afford the necessary facilities so that there may be no delay in the delivery of the papers of registration of the vessel as a Norwegian steamer.

It is understood that the Owners of the vessel are Messrs. Fearnley & Eger and that the port of registry is to be Christiania.
