Dear Sirs,

I enclose herewith a copy of a letter dated 17th instant received from Messrs. Lithgows, Ltd., relative to their steamer No. 724 - "BOGSTAD".

I should explain that there have recently been more than one cases of vessels built in this country for Norwegian Owners, and with a view to the issue by the Norwegian Consul General of a Certificate of Registry, he has been furnished either with a letter from this Office to the effect that the vessel is being constructed under the Special Survey of the Society's Surveyors with a view to classification in the Register Book, or with a Certificate on Form B stating that on completion, the vessel will be recommended for the Class 100A1, etc. In each case the Norwegian Consul-General here has issued the necessary papers without delay, subject to its being understood that the Certificate of Classification, when issued, will be exhibited to him.

I shall be glad if you will convey the above explanation to Messrs. Lithgow and ascertain their wishes in the matter. At the same time, you should let me know how the case stands, and when the steamer is expected to be completed.
