Dear Sir:-

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 17th. ultimo, requesting information concerning my 1st. Entry Report No. 841 on the S. S. "CANADIAN WINNER", I also herewith acknowledge your cable as follows:-

"Canadian Winner midship section not enclosed with first entry report."

In reply to your letter I have cabled to-day as follows:-

"CANADIAN WINNER" "STRINGER" "INCHES." AND
"Canadian Winner upper deck plate sixty two centre girder, margin plate thirty nine. towline hawsers warps correct report wrong"

I may state that the upper deck stringer in way of bridge deck is sixty two inches, that the breadth of brackets at centre girder are thirty nine inches, also the breadth of the margin plate brackets at intermediate framing are thirty nine inches.

With regard to the towline hawsers and wharps, the towline and stream chain are of 4-3/4 inch steel wire, the hawsers and wharps are of 2-3/4 and 2-1/2 inch steel wire and have stood tests to the requirements of Table 31.

Copy of the working midship section is enclosed herewith the approved Midship Section will be forwarded when the Sister Ship No. 12 in Builder's yard, now nearing completion is forwarded.

I regret these omissions and errors on my report No. 841.
