S.S. "SAN UGON"

ROPES AND WIRES CARRIED AWAY IN VERA CRUZ
DURING HURRICANE, SEPTEMBER 16th, 1931.

- Two (2) wires 1-1/8" diameter each 500 feet long,
75 feet broken from end of each.
- One (1) wire 1-1/8" diameter 500 feet long,
60 feet broken from end.
- Two (2) Manila ropes each 8" circumference and 90
fathoms long. Each parted 75 feet from end.
- One (1) Manila rope 8" circumference and 90 fathoms
long. Parted 60 feet from end.

NOTE: All ropes and wires above noted were brand
new having been supplied three (3) weeks
before accident and were in use for second
time only when hurricane broke vessel from
wharf.
