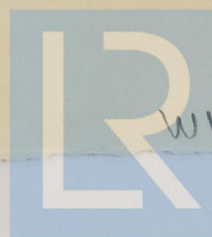
~~The Boiler Survey became due on this vessel at the end of October, 1936.~~
