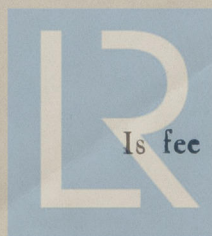
Special Survey No. 3. Has now been carried out and all necessary repairs to doors, companions, latches and closing appliances done.
