I duly received Mr. Barclay's letter of the 24th instant respecting the report on the donkey boiler for The Goole Shipbuilding & Repairing Co's No. 145 vessel (S.S. "TEES") and with regard to the statement contained therein that the boiler referred to in Leith Report No. 13365 was placed on board Messrs. Osbourne, Graham & Co's No. 159 vessel, I have to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Sunderland have now returned the report in question, which is enclosed herewith, and in which it is stated that the boiler is intended for The Goole Shipbuilding Co's No. 145 vessel.

I should add that Leith Report No. 13364 of survey held during construction on the donkey boiler No. 294 made by Messrs. G. Black & Sons for Messrs. Osbourne, Graham & Co's No. 159 vessel was sent to the Society's Surveyors at Sunderland on the 17th June last.
