The 3rd Special Survey No.1 and 2nd Special Survey No.3, which became due on these trawlers, respectively, in October, 1936, have been partly held.

In the former case the year of grace was granted by the Classing Committee, who subsequently granted a further extension until the 10th instant, on the definite understanding that the survey would be then completed.

In the case of the "NANCY HAGUE", which was reported in September last to be laid up indefinitely, the Owners furnished the usual undertaking.

Letters from the Owners have now been forwarded from the Society's Liverpool Office, requesting the withdrawal of both vessel's classes.

The year of grace, in each case, expired at the end of October last.

The cases were submitted to the Classing Committee on Tuesday, 14th instant, when they decided to give instructions for the character of each vessel to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line (—) indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Society's Liverpool Office have been informed accordingly.
