Gentlemen,

M. With reference to your First Entry Report No. 22847 on the steel S.S. "ARIAN" recently built by Messrs. Cochran & Sons, of Selby, I shall be glad if you will state if the thickness of the bulkhead plating is .25 of an inch as given on the report or .26 of an inch as required, and also whether the size and spacing of the vertical and horizontal stiffeners are as stated, and whether the vertical stiffeners on the collision bulkhead are spaced 30" as shown or 24" as required.

At the same time you should state the thickness of the rudder plating fitted in the vessel.

The report together with the approved plans of midship section and profile are returned herewith.
