

Letters have now been received from the Society's Surveyors at Marseilles and Paris, from which it is noted that the Owners have finally decided to class the vessel with the Bureau Veritas only, and consequently do not intend to maintain classification with this Society.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Tuesday, 16th instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

From the Shipping Papers it would appear that this vessel has since struck a mine off the Spanish Coast and grounded in the port of Palamos. The latest report, however, is that the Catalan Authorities have ordered the vessel to be sunk, but no confirmation on this point has yet come to hand.
