
S. I have to acquaint you that the Owners of the steamer "MARIE THERESE LE BORGNE" state that they are sending a Representative to Barcelona in connexion with the casualty sustained to this vessel last week.

The vessel has recently changed her class from Lloyd's Register to Bureau Veritas, but as it is not known whether there is still a Representative of the Bureau Veritas at Barcelona, it has been agreed that you will be in order, if requested by the Owners' Representative, in appointing Mr. Luna to hold a damage survey on this ship (as for an unclassified vessel) and issue a report to the Owners, who could afterwards, of course, pass it on to the Bureau Veritas.

I shall therefore be glad if you will kindly arrange accordingly should the Owners' Representative wish this course to be adopted.
