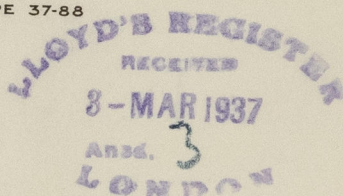

Dear Sir,

With reference to the S/S "MARIE THERESE LE BORGNE" ex "BRANCAS", which is now classed with the Bureau Veritas, as advised in my letter of the 26th instant, I beg to inform you that I have received from Mr. Le Borgne a communication on the following subject :-

This vessel, which has been seriously damaged by the explosion of a mine, last week, on the N.E. coast of Spain is now at Palamos (Barcelona district).

The Owners have been informed by Messrs Bureau Veritas that they have no news from their Surveyors in the Barcelona district. In the circumstances and should the Veritas Surveyors be missing, the Owners would be pleased to know whether Mr. Rennie, the Society's Surveyor at Barcelona could eventually undertake the inspection of the vessel at Palamos and they add that such a course has been proposed by the Bureau Veritas who would accept the Report of this Society's Surveyor. A reply by return would be greatly appreciated by the Owners.
