With reference to Glasgow report No. 39533 on the steamer "BRANCAS", it is concluded that the reverse frames at the intermediate brackets are as approved, that the rivets in the treble riveted butts, clear of the multiple punching, are spaced $3\frac{1}{2}$ diameters apart as required, and that the face bars on the reinforced frames in way of the 27" spacing are as approved.

I shall also be glad to learn whether the dry tank under the boilers has been tested and, if so, Mr. Edgar should state the length of this tank.
