Dear Sirs,

With reference to my letter of the 10th August  
S(Y). last and previous correspondence relative to the Boiler Survey  
which became due in January last on your Trawler "AVE MARIS  
STELLA", I beg to acquaint you that I am now advised by the  
Society's Surveyors at Antwerp that this vessel has been  
converted into a Motor Trawler, but that the oil engines  
were not constructed in accordance with the Society's Rules  
and were not installed under the supervision of the Society's  
Surveyors.

In all the circumstances, the Committee have had  
the case before them at their meeting today, and have had  
no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's  
class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line,  
indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
