Dear Sir,

With further reference to your query form of the 5th instant respecting the steam trawler "AVE MARIS STELLA" we have to inform you that during a recent visit paid by Mr. Rabaey to Ostend, he was informed by Messrs. Beliard, Crighton & Co that this vessel had been converted by them into a motor trawler

We were not informed that this work was contemplated or in hand and as the installation of the oil engines is complete it would appear that the vessel is no longer eligible to retain her class in the Register Book.

It would appear that several other trawlers have been converted into motor vessels by Messrs. Beliard, Crighton & Co and we have now written to them to find out the names of same and particulars of the motors.
