The vessel has recently been under survey at Middlesbrough for condition, when the Surveyors reported that this vessel had now been sold, and the New Owners wished to transfer her class to the Bureau Veritas.

In reply to enquiry, the Society's Paris Office, having taken the matter up with the New Owners, confirm that the vessel's class is no longer desired in the Society's Register Book.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, the 26th ultimo, when, in the circumstances, they decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and Three Dots (. . .) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
