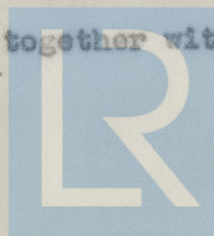

Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the case of the Steamer "LYRAS N", now named "BRESTOIS" which vessel it is understood is now your property, I beg to acquaint you that I am informed by the Society's Paris Office that they have taken up the matter of this vessel's classification in the Society's Register Book with your goodselves but that it is not your intention to maintain her class in the Register Book.

The case has been submitted for the consideration of the Committee at their meeting today and I have to inform you that, in view of your decision, instructions have been given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (. . .) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that, in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class, the record of the Freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding
