The Middlesbrough Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock and the bottom cleaned and coated.

It is stated the vessel has been sold and that the New Owners wish to withdraw the class.

Mr. Taxil of the Paris Office has taken the matter up with the New Owners ~~in~~ confirmation of this statement.

It is submitted the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
