Gentlemen,

I am in receipt of Mr. Dykes' letter of the 6th instant enclosing the freeboard report No. 12432 on the S.S. "MELBOURNE", and with regard thereto I send herewith the usual letters giving particulars of the freeboards which have been assigned to this vessel.

I have to inform you that it is concluded the under deck tonnage furnished is not the "Suez" tonnage but is measured in the same way as the British tonnage for vessels having cellular double bottoms rising at the margin, and the usual correction of minus .02 has therefore been made for the tonnage co-efficient of fineness and the freeboard computed accordingly.
