

The Dairen Kisen Kaisha own 50 vessels  
17 of which are classed with this Society and the  
remainder presumably with the Teikoku Kaiji Kyokai.  
Only six of them at present stand classed in the  
British Corporation Register.

Most of them are not due for any survey  
whatever, and in no case is there any important  
inspection badly overdue.

As was reported to the Committee last  
week the Owners have now decided to withdraw the  
classes of the 17 vessels mentioned above from the  
Society's Register Book.

Efforts have been made by the Society's  
Surveyor at Dairen and also by Mr. Jasper Cox, the  
Society's Principal Surveyor for the Far East, to  
induce the Owners to re-consider the matter, but  
without success; and the Classing Committee, to  
whom the cases were reported on Tuesday, 4th instant,  
gave instructions for the class of each vessel to  
be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots  
(. . .) to be inserted in lieu thereof, indicating  
1.38  
withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
