Translation of letter received from Messrs. Dairen Kisen Kaisha

Re Withdrawal of our Fleet from  
Your Society's Class.-

Dear Sir,

Although our Fleet has been registered under your Society's Classification for many years, we have now come to the conclusion that as the Safety at Sea Law has been in force for some years we hardly consider it necessary to continue their Class in any foreign Classification Society. Consequently we notified your Dairen Surveyor, Mr. Sim, the other day that we had decided to withdraw the 17 vessels of our Fleet.

Subsequently we received from you a cordial telegram regarding the above, but we wish it to be understood that we are not complaining of any dissatisfaction with your surveying duties or other services either at Dairen or on the Mainland, the reason being simply as stated above.

Lastly, we desire to take this opportunity to express our sincere thanks for the long patronage that you have bestowed upon us.
