The marks were found correct as follows:

Statutory deck line $1\frac{3}{4}$ inches above the steel upper deck at side

Centre of disc 6 ft. 2 inches below the statutory deck line

Load line in fresh water 6 inches above the centre of the disc

" " " Indian summer $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches above the centre of the disc

" " " summer at the centre of the disc

" " " winter $5\frac{1}{2}$ inches below the centre of the disc.
