Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Liverpool have forwarded to this Office a copy of a letter, dated 21st ultimo, received from your Superintendents intimating your decision to withdraw from the Society's Classification your Steam Trawlers "CENTIA", "GALLINULE", "COOSANER", and "THISTLE", and having submitted the same for the consideration of the Committee at their meeting to-day, I am directed to acquaint you that, in the circumstances, instructions have been given for the class of each of the three former vessels to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and Three Dots (. . .) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

With regard to the "THISTLE" I would remind you that the Third Special Survey No. 1 became due so long ago as February 1936 and has been only partly held, and that in March last, in order to meet your convenience the Committee deferred action for a short time, the year of grace having expired, on the understanding that the survey in question would be completed immediately after

In the circumstances, the Committee have had no alternative but to give instructions for this vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non compliance with the Society's Rules.
