The Third Special Survey No.1 became due on this vessel in February, 1936, and has been partly held.

In March last, in order to meet the Owners, the Classing Committee deferred action for a short time on the definite understanding that the Special Survey in question would be completed immediately after the busy Lenten fishing season.

In reply to enquiry the Society's Liverpool Office now forward a letter, dated 21st ultimo, received by them from the Owners' Superintendent, intimating that they no longer intend to maintain the classification of the trawler with this Society.

The year of grace expired at the end of February last.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Tuesday, 4th instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line (5.37), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
