I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th instant respecting your motorship "CORABANK" and to acquaint you that the case has been considered by the Classing Committee at their meeting today.

They note the special circumstances under which you are anxious to defer the completion of the First Special Survey No.1 until the vessel's return to this side from the Far East at the beginning of 1938, and I have the pleasure to say that they are agreeable to this postponement.

With regard to the Load Line Certificate, which expires on the 15th August next, it will be necessary for a general examination to be made in order that the Certificate may be extended as desired. It is suggested that this examination might be made at Shanghai, and perhaps you will kindly advise me of her anticipated date of arrival at that port, and at the same time let me have more exact particulars of the date to which you desire to extend the Certificate.
