Dear Dr. Montgomerie,

With reference to my letter of the 28th. June last respecting the steamer " Anglo " I have today written an official letter to the Secretary regarding the completion of the Special Survey etc. and I think it is correct for me to write you a private letter regarding this case.

I see from the Norske Veritas supplement for June that this vessel has been classed by Det Norske Veritas.

On seeing Mr. Skogland at Haugesund on Saturday and asking him if he had made any definite arrangements for completion of the Special Survey etc. he stated that he did not intend to carry out the requirements before January as the vessel was now classed by Det Norske Veritas and further it would not be possible for him to do so as the vessel's charter expired end of December.

He stated also that if a postponement was granted to the end of January he would retain the vessel's classification with this Society. Of course it must be understood that his word cannot be trusted.
