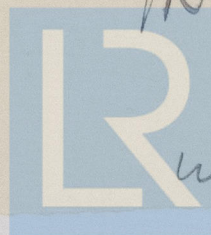
The 2nd Special Survey No.3 became due on this vessel at the end of March last.
