We beg to inform you with respect to first entry report on hull of the M/V "SENSAN MARU" recently despatched from this port that the sheer strake and strake below at the ends of the vessel is as approved (i.e. .42" forward and aft) and the decks, tunnel and bulkheads have been tested as per Rule and found satisfactory.

The freeboard was not assigned by this Society, and therefore, it was not verified by us.
