I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Dunkirk Surveyor has forwarded to this Office your letter to him of the 22nd ultimo respecting the cases of your steamers "ALSACIEN" and "LORRAIN", from which it is noted that these vessels are now classed with the Bureau Veritas, and that you no longer desire to maintain their classification with this Society.

In the circumstances the Committee, who have had the cases under consideration, have given instructions for the character of each vessel to be withdrawn and Three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
