Nature of Survey

First Entry.

It is submitted before this case receives the consideration of the Committee the Surveyors should be requested to state whether the poop and forecastle are permanently enclosed spaces and intended for cargo, also whether cargo is to be carried in the bridge space, in view of the statement on their report that cargo battens are not fitted in the bridge and forecastle tween decks.

The Surveyors should also be informed it is concluded cargo battens are fitted between the 2<sup>nd</sup> tier of beams and upper deck, but they should be requested to state if this is so.
