I beg to acquaint you that your letter of the 28th ultimo addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Grimsby respecting your Trawler "LUDA LADY" has been forwarded to this Office.

The case has received the consideration of the General Committee at their meeting to-day who note that you no longer desire to continue the classification of this vessel with this Society, and in view of the fact that the Second Special Survey No.2 became due so long ago as July, 1935 and has not yet been completed, the Committee have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
