The class is subject to shell plate H5, starboard side, and 2 frames in way, found slightly set in being dealt with at the next Special Survey.

The 1st S.S.No.2 will not become due until 7,38, and it was recently stated this would be carried out at Hamburg when the vessel was next drydocked.

The Hamburg Surveyors have been advised accordingly.

The vessel recently changed Ownership and the Hamburg Surveyors now enclose a letter from the Owners to the effect that they have decided to class the ship with the Germanischer Lloyd, and they desire the class with this Society be withdrawn.

It is submitted the vessel's class be withdrawn from the Register Book and Three Dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
