Dear Sirs,

S. I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Lisbon have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 21st instant relative to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "MOZAMBIQUE".

As you are aware the Third Special Survey No.1 became due on this vessel so long ago as October, 1936, and has not yet been completed.

The year of grace allowed under the Society's Rules for the completion of this survey expired in October last, and in view of the intimation expressed in your communication above referred to that you have decided to dispose of the vessel and do not intend to maintain her class in the Register Book, the Committee have given instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
