The greater part of the Third Special Survey No.1, which became due on this vessel in October 1936, has been held, but some repairs are required to girders under boiler stools, steering engine and windlass, bulkheads &c., and eight lengths of worn chain cable require to be renewed.

Successive postponements of the Special Survey have been granted by the Classing Committee, it being understood that the Owners were in negotiation for the purchase of another vessel, which, if completed, would result in the present vessel being scrapped.

On the 15th instant, in view of a communication received from the Lisbon Surveyors to the effect that the vessel was laid up, the Owners were requested to furnish the usual undertaking.

A letter from the Owners has now been forwarded by the Surveyors, stating that they have decided to dispose of the vessel for sale, and therefore do not intend to maintain her class in the Register Book.

The year of grace expired in October last.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Tuesday, the 29th instant, when they decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Lisbon Surveyors have been requested by cablegram to inform the Owners accordingly.
