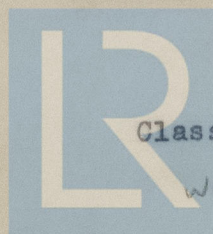
Your remarks on the matter have been carefully noted, but I am directed to say that it is thought that these renewals should not have been found necessary so soon after the survey for classification was carried out.
