




T.S.S. "MOCAMBIQUE".

The Lisbon Surveyor now forwards a reply to the enquiry contained in the Classing letter dated 22.8.33 regarding certain renewals that were found necessary to be effected at Lisbon shortly after the survey for classification had been held. The Surveyor states that the shell plating in the counter, deck plating in way of Engineers' quarters, and the tank top plating in way of No. 2 tank were examined by him at the classification survey and found satisfactory.

In view of the short time that has elapsed since the classification survey was held, it is thought that renewals to the above parts should not have been found necessary so soon after this survey.

It is submitted the Lisbon Surveyor be informed that in future cases ^{when carrying out special surveys} he should satisfy himself that the vessel is placed in such a condition as to entitle her to retain her class until the next special survey, with the exception of any minor repairs which may become necessary during that period.
