This vessel was built in 1908, and was surveyed at Lisbon by Mr. Scullard in August 1931/October 1932 with a view to classification with this Society, and the class 100A1 "With Freeboard" was assigned in 10,32.

A report has now been received from Lisbon of a survey held by Mr. Dixon (acting during Mr. Scullard's absence on holiday in this country) from which it appears that certain renewals due to wear and tear have been effected to the shell plating, deck plating in way of the Engineers' quarters and the tank top plating in way of No.2 tank.

It is not understood why these renewals should have been found necessary such a short time after the survey for classification was completed, and it is submitted Mr. Scullard might be requested to forward his remarks on the survey held by Mr. Dixon.
