and now confirm our reply as follows:-

"MOÇAMBIQUE BOILER SURVEY WILL BE HELD ON RETURN MONTH OF MAY"

I have to acquaint you that yesterday afternoon the matter was discussed with the Engineer Superintendent and arrangements made for the Boiler Survey to be held on the vessel's return early in the month of May.
