Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 15th instant enclosing Special Survey Request Form in respect of the classification of the T.S.S. "MOCAMBIQUE", and the contents have been noted.

With regard thereto I have to state that plans of this vessel have been received from Messrs. A. Stephens & Sons, and it is found that the principal scantlings of the structure are such as could be accepted as being equivalent to the Society's Standard. The construction of the detailed parts of the structure are also such as could be accepted, with the exception of the weather deck hatch coamings, hatch webs on all decks, lower deck girders in way of No.2 hatch, and the watertight bulkheads. The reinforcement required in respect of these items, in order that they may be equivalent to the requirements of the Rules, have been indicated on the various plans.

I am therefore directed to state that provided the requirements of the Rules for vessels not built under survey be complied with, the scantlings be verified, the additional strengthening indicated on the plans be carried out to your satisfaction, and the vessel be found or placed in a thoroughly

good and efficient condition, she will be eligible to be classed 100A- With Freeboard corresponding to a Complete Superstructure Vessel.

You should specially satisfy yourself that the material of the double bottom in way of the pillars is in good condition, and provides an adequate support for these members. You should also satisfy yourself that the construction of the bottom is equivalent to the Committee's practice.

If the figure "I" is desired, particulars of the equipment on board the vessel should be submitted for consideration.

In order that a freeboard might be assigned the usual particulars, as required on form 11c, should be forwarded to this Office.

As desired I have today forwarded to your address 21 plans of this vessel, and the duplicates are being retained in this Office for record.
