E. With reference to the proposed classification of the T.S.S. "MOCAMBIQUE", I enclose herewith plans of the boilers and pumping arrangement, and have to acquaint you that provided the working parts of the machinery be opened up, examined and found in good order, the sizes of the shafting be such as could be accepted, the boilers be examined internally and externally, found in good order and safe working condition and their scantlings be as shown on the plan, the machinery of this vessel will be accepted and a notation of LMC (with date) without the distinguishing mark * assigned, subject to the drains from No.4 lower tween deck to the tunnel space being fitted with self-closing cocks.

It is concluded that a bilge injection is fitted.
