

Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the classification in the Register Book of the steamer "SOUTHLAND", I beg to remind you that the Special Survey No.1 became due so long ago as May, 1931 but has not yet been held and action has been deferred as the vessel has been laid up on an undertaking received from the late Owners, that the overdue Special Survey and repairs would be carried out before the vessel left port.

The Committee have again had the case before them at their meeting today together with a further letter from the Dunedin Surveyor intimating the the vessel is still laid up indefinitely at Port Chalmers.

As you are no doubt aware the Special Survey No.2 became due in May last and will require to be carried out as no part of the Special Survey No.1 has been held, and I have to say that the Committee will be agreeable to the vessel's class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed for the present, whilst laid up, subject to the conditions set forth on the enclosed form of undertaking, which I shall be glad if you will kindly
