I enclose herewith a copy of a letter dated the 23rd December received from the Society's Surveyor at Dunedin, N.Z. from which you will see that three new cylinders have been supplied for the twin screw motorship "SOUTHLAND", owned by the Bluff Harbour Board, one of which has been fitted in place of No. 5 starboard originally supplied to the vessel.

The engines as you will observe were made by Messrs. Vickers, Petters Ltd., and I have been in communication with the Society's Surveyor at Ipswich regarding the matter and he states that the cylinders in question were not sent from Ipswich as Messrs. Petters works were dismantled some twelve months ago.

It is therefore concluded that the cylinders referred to were made at their Yeovil works, and I shall be glad if you will kindly enquire of Messrs. Vickers, Petters, Ltd. and let me know whether any new cylinders have recently been supplied by them for this vessel.
