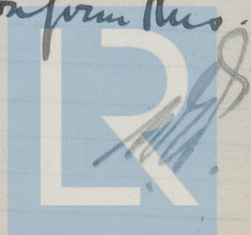

FREEBOARD REPORT on ~~the~~ Messrs. the Dublin Dockyard's N^o 120 Ship.

It is submitted the freeboards given on the accompanying form being those required by the Tables merit approval, the same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification, and recorded in the Register Book, subject to the dimensions particulars now supplied being verified on completion.

It is concluded that the Moulded Depth to the Upper Deck is 20'-0 $\frac{1}{4}$ ", the moulded depth to 2nd. Deck and the height of 'tween-decks being given on the freeboard report as 12'-6" and 7'-6 $\frac{1}{4}$ " respectively, but the Surveyor should confirm this.
