I have to acquaint you that the steamer "LORD BROUGHTON" ex "PATMOS" was recently classed 100A1 with records of S.S.Nwc. No.3-12,20 and LMC.12,20, as the result of a survey held by the Newcastle Surveyors.

The Master has now called at this Office and stated that the vessel has lost her third bower anchor and that a new anchor will be obtained and sent to Cardiff to be placed on board in about a week's time. He was informed for his guidance that the equipment letter of the vessel is "S".
